## **COMPLAINT FOR BREACH OF CONTRACT**

#### **PARTIES**

- 1. John Smith is a natural person and resides in Baltimore County, Maryland.

- 6. Each defendant resides, carries on a regular business, is employed, habitually engages in a vocation, or maintains a principal office in Baltimore County. Accordingly, venue is proper in this Court pursuant to MD. CODE, CTS. & JUD. PROC. § 6-201(a).

#### FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- 7. On or about October 31, 2022, Plaintiffs and Defendants entered into a valid and enforceable contract while possessing the legal capacity to do so. A true and accurate copy of the contract is attached.
- 8. Plaintiffs performed all necessary conditions precedent and honored all other obligations under the contract that applied to Plaintiffs as follows:
  - Paragraph 3 of the Purchase Agreement stated, "John & Jane Doe shall pay \$1,000.00 within 30 days after executing the contract." Mr. and Mrs. Doe made the payment as agreed.
